Quick test for Fast Track Numeracy

Have a go at these questions. Take about 15 minutes.

- 1) A recipe uses six eggs to make a tortilla. How many eggs does a cook need to make three of these tortillas?
- 2) This room is about 20 degrees. What kind of degrees is the temperature measured in?
- 3) Say time is 0935. What will the time be in 45 minutes?
- 4) You make ten cakes for a school event. The ingredients cost you £1.50. The school sells the cakes at £0.25 each. Write down the calculation you would use to work out the difference between the cost of making the cakes and the money the school raised
- 5) 8 tomatoes cost £1.20. What will 5 tomatoes cost?
- 6) The population of Wales is about 2 950 000. One in five of the population speaks Welsh. How many people speak Welsh?
- 7) Special Offer! One third off! The settee cost £420 before the sale. How much is one third of the cost?
- 8) This room is about 8m wide and 7m deep and roughly in the shape of a rectangle. You calculate the area of a rectangle by multiplying the width by the depth. What is the area of the room?
- 9) A charity sale raises £240. Three quarters of the money goes to the charity. How much does the charity receive?
- 10) You buy a sandwich for £1.25, a cup of coffee for 60p and a flapjack for 70p. How much change will you get from a £5 note?

I have used similar language to the Numeracy test. These questions are about Level 1 ish but they are harder to do because I have not given you four answers to choose from.

Answers

- 1) 18
- 2) Celsius
- 3) 1020
- 4) £0.25 × 10 £1.50 = £1.00
- 5) £1.20 \div 8 = £0.15 × 5 = £0.75 (accept 75p)
- 6) $2950000 \div 5 = 590000$
- 7) $420 \div 3 = £140$
- 8) $8 \times 7 = 56 \text{ m}^2$
- 9) $\frac{3}{4} \times £240 = £180$
- 10) £1.25 + 0.60 + 0.70 = £2.55. £5.00 - £2.55 = £2.45
