One side guide: Foreign Currency Conversion



Rate is the value of £1 in the foreign currency. As of July 2009, some rates are shown in the table below...

Country	Currency	£1=
Euro zone	Euro €	1.16
US	Dollar \$	1.64
India	Rupee (Rs)	79.65
Pakistan	Rupee (Rs)	134.82
Japan	Yen ¥	153.72

The UK currency is called 'Sterling' if you want to search for current rates.

Worked Examples

Foreign currency questions with 'real' rates like the ones I'm using on this worksheet are found in the calculator section. You might see questions with 'simple' rates (e.g. £1 = €1.20) in the non calculator section.

Going abroad

EG1) Nigel is going to Osaka and is taking £350 with him. How many Yen will Nigel receive for his Sterling?

Strategy: Nigel is leaving UK, so *multiply* his £ by the exchange rate, 153.72.

Calculation: 350 × 153.72 = 53 802 Yen

Coming back to UK

EG2) Jamilla has returned from a trip to Goa and has 830 Rupees left. How much is this in pounds?

Strategy: Jamilla is returning, so *divide* by the rate of 79.65

Calculation: $830 \div 79.65 = £10.42$ (round off to nearest 1p)

- 4. Edna is going to Prague. She is taking £125, and the exchange rate is £1 = 30.12 Czech Crowns. How many Crowns will Edna receive?
- 5. Midori San's restaurant in Osaka serves a traditional Japanese lunch for ¥750 and a beer costs ¥400. How much is the total in Sterling?
- 6. Hard: A Maths textbook costs 280 Rupees in Mumbai, India. How much would the same book cost in Lahore in Pakistan?
